Regional News Round-Up

Runway 4-22 at **Baltimore/Washington International Airport** has been closed permanently, effective August 6. As part of a series of airfield improvements, the little-used runway will be converted into a taxiway. Runway 15R-33L also is currently closed for reconstruction.

The **Salisbury-Ocean City: Wicomico Regional Airport** has received a \$5.5 million FAA grant to renovate runway 2-23, which hasn't seen significant repairs since the late 1970s. The runway will be rated for 100,000 pounds after the improvements, and upgrade from 50,000 pounds. The work will require approximately 300 days, and could begin as early as this fall.



The Stafford County Board of Supervisors deferred a vote on plans for the planned Oakenwold housing development, which had attracted concern due to its proximity to **Stafford Regional Airport**. Most residential units would be more than a mile from the center of the runway, but at its closest point, the development would be 3600 feet from the runway.

The Warren County Board of Supervisors has approved the purchase of property neighboring the **Warren County Airport**. The FAA required the land to be acquired in order to address trees and other protrusions into the airport flight path. The county will pay \$390,000 for 5.85 acres of land from two sets of property owners, of which approximately \$165,000 will be funded by FAA and state grants.
