

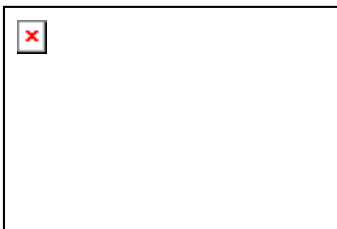

Regional News Round-Up

The Department of Justice has approved the acquisition of Landmark Aviation by Signature Flight Support, but on the condition that it sell FBOs at six airports to third parties - one of those airports being **Washington Dulles International Airport**.



The Fauquier County Board of Supervisors is reviewing plans for a new terminal at the **Warrenton-Fauquier Airport**. The state would cover approximately 70% of the cost of the project, which is estimated to be \$2.4 million, and is intended to attract additional corporate operations. Also under review are other improvements, including to taxiways and the parking lot.

Gordonsville's town council is considering future options for **Gordonsville Municipal Airport**, which is currently operated by Gordonsville Aero Services but will revert to town control in July. The town held a meeting with the state Department of Aviation and airport users in January, and has developed a five-year capital improvement plan, which is available at <http://www.townofgordonsville.org/DocumentCenter/View/3546>.

A federal judge in Virginia has issued a \$5.4 million judgment against the U.S., finding that ATC negligence caused the midair accident near **Warrenton-Fauquier Airport** on May 28, 2012 that killed an NTSB official, James Duncan, and a passenger aboard his Beechcraft Bonanza. The U.S. previously settled the claim of the pilot of the other aircraft, who survived. As always, fly safely!
