Regional News Round-Up

The most recent issue of NBAA's *Business Aviation Insider* reports on the efforts that have been made to reopen **Reagan National Airport** to general aviation traffic. In the past year, the TSA has made the SCA Access Standard Security Program (DASSP) more flexible – such as by making it easier to change aircraft, crew, and departure/arrival times. The **Stafford Regional Airport Authority** at its July 10 meeting discussed plans to remove trees that interfere with the glidepath to Runway 33. An environmental report is expected to be completed by mid-August. The authority also discussed plans for the construction of a new



terminal; the low bid for the project - which has been accepted - was reported to be \$2.7 million, and completion of the project is planned for 2013.

MAG, Inc., a Philadelphia-based aircraft maintenance and repair company, has announced plans to establish a facility at **Hagerstown Regional Airport**.

The pilot of a Wag Aero Sportsman 2x2made an emergency landing at **Culpeper Regional Airport** on July 3 after his elevator controls malfunctioned. One of the occupants of a Beechcraft BE23 was killed, and another injured, in an accident near **Davis Airport** on July 16. As always, fly safely!
