## Regional News Round-Up

GWBAA President Paige Kroner recently provided comments to an NBAA article highlighting the runway extension project now under way at **Manassas Regional Airport**. "Aircraft that haven't used Manassas before this expansion will now be able to utilize the airport and its full-service facilities," which include two FBOs and customs facilities. Once complete, the runway will be 6200 feet in length. The work is expected to be finished by November 30; until then, there will be periodic restrictions on the usable length of the runway.

Neighbors of **Montgomery County Airpark** have requested that the FAA designate the area as "congested," which potentially would place restrictions on overflights. The "Airpark Concerned Citizens Association" asserts that the airport has ignored complaints about noise.

The NBAA Air Traffic Services desk has issued a warning about an error in Jeppesen chart effective July 26, 2012 for the FRDMM ONE ARRIVAL (10-2C) and TRUPS ONE RNAV ARRIVAL (10-2H) at **Reagan Washington National Airport**. The charts show the LACKE waypoint as a "Fly Over"; it should be depicted as a "Fly By". Corrected charts will be included in the August 31 revision; an alert also has been posted on the Jeppesen website at <http://ww1.jeppesen.com/documents/aviation/notices-alerts/chart-alert/KDCA/KDCAalert.pdf>.
