The Charles County Chamber of Commerce has established a task force to help promote the use of **Maryland Airport** in Indian Head. A runway extension – to 3750 feet – is expected to be completed in July; a further extension is planned to be completed by 2015.

Kevin Daugherty, the current manager of **Frederick Municipal Airport**, has been named as the new manager of the Brooksville-Tampa Airport in Florida.

The **Maryland Aviation Administration** on June 12 hosted a conference on the importance of aviation in the state, including GA12. Harry Houckes, NBAA's Southeast Regional Representative, noted that: "It's a great way to showcase all that aviation does for the local community to the media, local government officials and the business community."
