Participation in the program also provides protection to flight crew members and operators from FAA enforcement action relating to a self-disclosed incident. FAA Reauthorization Update

Congress has passed a short-term FAA funding bill, which funds the agency through May 31, 2016 - but this only delays debate over long-term questions. It is important that the voice of business aviation - and not just airlines and other interests - be heard on Capitol Hill. Regional News Round-Up



The Frederick Board of Aldermen have approved the acceptance of a \$2.7 million FAA grant for the demolition of buildings in the path of a planned runway extension at **Frederick Municipal Airport**. Runway 5-23 is to be lengthened from 5,280 feet to 6,000 feet. Demolition is expected to begin in November.

On October 16, a Titan Tornado out of **Manassas Regional Airport** crashed and hit a fence at the Coffeewood Correctional Facility in Culpeper County. No injuries were reported. As always, fly safely!
