Salisbury-Ocean City Wicomico Regional Airport is in the processing of interviewing Airport manager candidates. The previous manager, Bob Bryant, recently departed after 23 years at the airport.

A runway extension project at **Hagerstown Regional Airport** (to 7,000 feet) was completed ten years ago; according to data released by Washington County, since then the jobs generated by the airport have almost doubled, to nearly 1,500, and the personal annual income attributable to them totals almost \$80 million.
