- Biz av operators may see some relief from congestion as the FAA implements sweeping changes over the next year to the airspace along the Eastern seaboard. Operators will see significant changes ahead of the project's targeted November 2020 completion date, with the first event coming Oct. 10 as high altitude "J-routes" in the Atlantic Corridor are replaced with "Y-routes" optimized for performance-based

navigation capabilities. Low-altitude routes will be similarly replaced Nov. 7, with all J-routes from Florida replaced by Jan. 30, 2020. See <https://nbaa.org/aircraft-operations/airspace/nec-optimization-project-promises-nextgen-benefits-east-coast-flights/>.

Regional News Round-Up

Flying to Boston Logan Airport? Be aware due to the Terminal E Modernization Project, the ramp space available to Signature Flight Support will be significantly limited for at least the next year. Operations at Signature will **require** a reservation, in 4 hour slots. The following is the actual NOTAM text: "**BOS 10/320 (KBOS A0708/19) BOS APRON GA RAMP CLSD EXC MIL OPS AND LIFE FLT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT 4 HR PPR 617-561-2500 1910210400-2312310400.**" Also expect Hanscom to see a significant uptick in traffic. Additionally, pending weather, re-positioning flights between Hanscom and Logan could experience significant delays.

The Winchester Regional Airport Authority has voted to reduce its operational hours from round-the-clock to 6am to 10pm, with an on-call procedures for after-hours flights.

Bedford County is considering plans for the expansion of **New London Airport** to include a flight school for Liberty University; a formal proposal is expected in November.
