Regional News Round-Up

Salisbury-Wicomico Airport has secured \$4 million in funding for improvements to the airport's water main, allowing it to be connected to the city of Salisbury's water system – which in turn is expected to enable additional development at the airport.

The Annapolis newspaper *Bay Weekly* profiled **Lee Airport**, noting that it is one of the 35 remaining community airports in Maryland – and under threat. The current owner, Van Lee, is part of a family that originally established the airport since 1939, but the number of aircraft based at the airport have declined from 115 to 76 since 2000, even while open land near the airport has been developed.

Bedford County, Virginia officials continue to develop a proposed zoning ordinance amendment to create an airport district – which would outline how airports could be developed in the county – amid concerns from residents about Liberty University's proposed expansion of the **New London Airport**.

A high school sophomore's Eagle Scout project was the renovation of the observation deck at **Manassas Regional Airport**.
