Regional News Round-Up

Manassas Regional Airport is continuing to seek federal support for funds to replace its control tower, which was erected at the airport in 1992 but is actually almost 60 years-old, having been purchased from an airport in Colorado. Airport Director Juan Rivera has stated that a new tower is expected to cost \$8 million.

The Baltimore Sun reported that Carroll County had adopted local ordinances for drones that were preempted by state law (without addressing whether they are all preempted by federal law). See
