Regional News Round-Up

The Clarke County Board of Supervisors had endorsed an application by **Winchester Regional Airport** for financial support from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Rural Development Loan Program for the construction of a new terminal.

Electra, a hybrid-electric aerospace company, has opened a new research and development facility in Manassas, and leased an 18,000-square foot hangar at **Manassas Regional Airport**.

Starting on September 13, Tailwind Air plans to offer twice-daily 90-minute flights between Manhattan's Skyport Marina on East 23rd Street and **College Park Airport**.

A Loudoun County Circuit Court has denied a request for an injunction by ProJet Aviation against Kuhn Jet Center starting operations as a second FBO at **Leesburg Executive Airport**. Although the ruling concluded that ProJet would not be immediately harmed by Kuhn's operations, it is not a ruling on the merits of the litigation.

An article in the *Washington Post* describes complaints about noise by neighbors of **Dulles International Airport** (<https://www.washingtonpost.com/transportation/2022/08/09/dulles-airport-noise-loudoun-county/>); the article recounts plan to revise Loudoun County's zoning maps, but the limited legal and practical options for reducing noise. In other Dulles news, Dominion Energy has proposed to build an 835-acre solar farm at the airport, which would be the largest such facility in the U.S.
