

Regional News Round-Up

Effective October 6, the UNICOM/CTAF frequency for **Winchester Regional Airport** will change to 122.975. The purpose of the change is to decrease the amount of frequency congestion from other airports in the region.

Stafford Regional Airport has formally opened a 1,000-foot extension of its runway, providing it with a total length of 6,000 feet. The extension is expected to enable larger aircraft to use the aircraft, as well as to drive fuel sales and other economic development.

The Prince George's County Council reportedly is continuing to consider options for rezoning **Freeway Airport** in Bowie, based on the current owners' interest in redeveloping the property. A revised proposal reportedly is being prepared for its review before the November election, contrary to objections from neighbors.

The start-up of Tailwind Air's planned seaplane service from **College Park Airport** to Manhattan has been delayed, reportedly because of security concerns.

Recent recipients of FAA grants include **Frederick Municipal Airport** (\$5.4 million, for runway construction), **Easton Airport** (\$1.5 million, for runway construction), and **Carroll County Regional Airport** (\$2.9 million, for runway rehabilitation).

Alfred “Al” Pollard is retiring after 25 years at **Martin State Airport** (including as the head of operations and maintenance since 2006).

Winchester Regional Airport has awarded a \$10.2 million contract to G-W Management Services, LLC for the construction of a new terminal; part of the funding will come from a Virginia Department of Aviation grant.
