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Regional News Round-Up

The Town of Leesburg is setting aside funding for a temporary control tower at **Leesburg Executive Airport** (to replace the to-be-decommissioned remote tower system), accompanied by the funding of an initial siting study for the long-term project of designing and funding a permanent facility. The Town will pay to rent the temporary tower but the controllers will be paid by FAA; FAA will also pay to upgrade the temporary tower's radar capabilities, which it will initially lack, in contrast to the remote tower.

Hagerstown Regional Airport announced that no discrepancies were found in its annual inspection by the FAA; because it hosts commercial operations, HGR has a Part 139 certificate from FAA, which requires that certain safety and operational standards be maintained and periodically reviewed.

The Loudoun County of Supervisors authorized a \$70,000 study to propose noise mitigation options for **Washington Dulles International Airport**, and reported that it has not been successful in outreach to FAA to discuss the issues.

The Virginia Aviation Board has announced \$6.5 million in state grants for 21 airports across the state, including \$2.1 million for taxiway and apron rehabilitation at **Leesburg Executive Airport**. (In other JYO news, nine aircraft were reported to have been damaged in a hangar fire on June 25.)

Senator Kaine visited **Winchester Regional Airport** on June 26, to visit the construction site for the airport's new terminal. The \$10 million project is part of \$40 million in investment anticipated over the next five years.

The Manassas City Council is considering a proposal from Avports to upgrade the terminal at **Manassas Regional Airport** to enable it to support commercial flights. Airport Director Juan Rivera said the plans would have minimal effects on general aviation.

On June 3, a biplane crashed on landing at **Easton Airport**. No injuries were reported. As always, fly safely!
