Regional News Round-Up

Neighbors of **Montgomery County Airpark** are reported to continue to express concerns about the airport, including that an Airpark Community Advisory Committee authorized by the County Council last year has yet to meet.

At a February meeting of the Airport Commission, Juan Rivera, the Director of **Manassas Regional Airport**, provided a report on the plans for the airport to accept commercial traffic, including firefighting and security requirements.

The Leesburg Town Council was reported to be hopeful hopeful that the state budget would cover the 2025-26 rent for **Leesburg Executive Airport's** mobile ATC tower; an agreement with the FAA provides that the agency will staff the tower but the Town must fund its rent, while long-term plans are under development.

The College Park Council has sent a letter to **College Park Airport**, asking that it be prepared to expedite the transition to unleaded avgas.

Tipton Airport is working with the Anne Arundel schools and other prospective partners to develop a maintenance training program at the airport.

An aircraft made an emergency landing at **Stafford Regional Airport** on March 7; no injuries were reported. As always, fly safely!
